



## **Georgia's web-based property inventory named Overall Winner of NASFA Innovation Award**

*June 2008, Lake Tahoe* -- The National Association of State Facilities Administrators selected Georgia as the Overall Winner of the 2007 Innovations Award for the state's Building, Land & Lease Inventory of Property (BLLIP) online application.

Innovations Award was established by NASFA in 1993 to recognize outstanding achievement by a state facility organization in establishing an innovative new program or improving an existing program which increases the efficiency and effectiveness of government.

Georgia's BLLIP is an interactive web-based geographical information system designed to enable users to query, search and generate reports using real time information about State-owned and -leased properties and buildings. Users can locate real property assets by geo-coded information and graphically view the information on a map. Current aerial photographs are also available as well as relevant PDF files, such as deeds).

On May 15, 2006 BLLIP went live at its new web address

- 1,695 leases for the State of Georgia, which can be sorted by city, county, landlords, lease terms, etc.
- 15,017 state buildings
- all 1.1 million acres of state-owned land

The implementation of BLLIP enables the state and the public at large to know every piece of property that is owned or leased in the name of the State of Georgia.

The winners of the 2007 NASFA Innovations Awards, sponsored by VFA, were recognized at an awards banquet during the NASCA & NASFA National Conference & Resource Expo, June 10 – 14, 2008 in Lake Tahoe, Nevada.
